INTEGRATION AGREEMENT

In order to facilitate the **inclusion** of people coming from third countries, who **come to Italy for the first time** and submit a **residence request** for a period of **not less than one year**, the Italian State has established an Integration Agreement with which it undertakes to offer free educational and civic services.

WHAT IT FORESEES

- **Learning the Italian language** in order to achieve at least **level A2** of the Common European Framework of Reference for the knowledge of languages (Cefr).
- **Learning about civil life in Italy**, that is for example, how the health system and the schools work.
- **Respecting compulsory schooling**, enrolling girls and boys in school.
- Expressing their consent to the **Charter of Citizenship and Integration Values**.
- Obtaining 30 credits within two years, extendable for another year, in order for it to be considered valid.



Starting from its signing, **16 credits** are recognized which will be confirmed or increased, by acquiring **knowledge of the Italian language, civic culture and civil life**.

At the end of the two years, the Immigration Office ("Sportello unico per l'Immigrazione"), present in each Prefecture, will assess the level of integration achieved by requesting specific documentation.



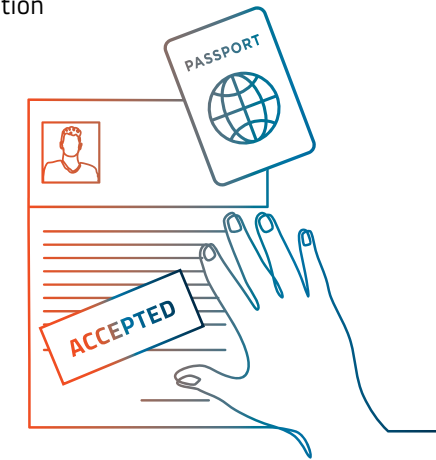
ACQUIRING CITIZENSHIP

One of the mandatory requirements for the acquisition of the **right to Italian citizenship** is knowing the Italian language, at a level not lower than B1 of the Cefr, according to law 132/2018.

Those who apply for citizenship must have a **qualification issued** by a public or private educational institution, recognized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation and/or by the Ministry of Education, or they must present the certification of knowledge of the Italian language issued by one of the four certifying bodies, namely the Roma Tre University, the University for Foreigners of Siena, the University for Foreigners of Perugia and the Dante Alighieri Society.

Applications for citizenship by marriage and residence are accepted only if the person from a third country produces a self-certification of possession of the qualification or certification attesting his/her level of knowledge of the Italian language.

Those who have signed the Integration Agreement or are holders of EU residence permits for a long period are excluded from the obligation to certify their knowledge of the Italian language, as it is already required by law.



LEARNING THE ITALIAN LANGUAGE

The goal of **Prils Lazio 5** is to spread and consolidate the knowledge of the **Italian language, culture and civic responsibilities** among people who come from third countries and who stay regularly in Lazio, in order to achieve better integration into society.

WHO IS IT FOR?

- **Adults, young adults and minors from third countries over the age of 16**, even in conditions of vulnerability and/or at risk of marginalization.
- **Public entities and qualified entities** that carry out activities in the field of civic-linguistic training.

WHAT IT INCLUDES

- **Free and personalized courses** for levels alpha, preA1, A1, A2, B1 foreseen by the Cefr.
- **Face-to-face and remote training** with innovative teaching methods.
- **Welcoming and guidance** to assess the needs of each person.
- Babysitting, tutoring and cultural mediation services.

The Prils Plan, now in its fifth edition, is one of the language training courses that the Lazio Region carries out in collaboration with the **Regional School Office for Lazio** (Usr Lazio), the **10 Provincial Centers for Adult Education** (Cpia) of Roma Capitale and the provinces of Viterbo, Rieti, Frosinone and Latina, the **bodies qualified** for teaching the Italian language L2 and **Laziocrea**. In addition, the **5 Prefectures** of Lazio, **local authorities** that support the projects of the **Reception and Integration System** (Sai, formerly Sprar) and the **National Association of Italian Municipalities** (Anci) have adhered to the project.
